Amen.

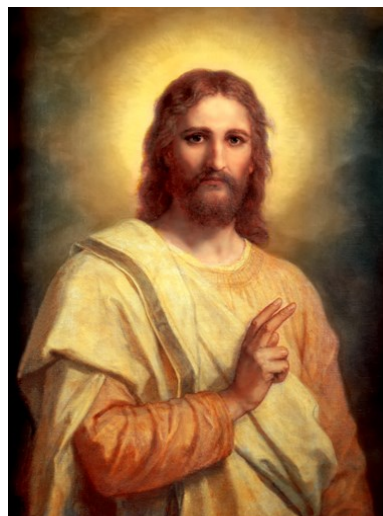


Figure of Christ
