GUIDELINES FOR LENT AND EASTER 2022

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or the ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, April 15, are days of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

THE "NUN RUN"

We are very blessed to have two communities of Religious Women living in New Kent County. The Poor Clare Nuns in Barhamsville in eastern New Kent and the Little Sisters of St. Francis in Quinton in western New Kent. The Poor Clare Nuns are at Bethlehem Monastery praising God and interceding for His suffering people. They are a cloistered community who work and pray primarily in silence. If you would like to entrust your special needs and intentions to their prayers, please contact them at 757-566-1684. The Poor Clares are vegetarian but do eat fish twice a week. They can use canned veggies, fruit, rice, flour, salt, canned tuna and salmon as well as paper products, toothpaste and soap. The Little Sisters of St. Francis' Seton House provides care for severely physically and mentally challenged adults who require 24/7 care. The Little Sisters are a missionary community of Catholic sisters who reach out to the poor and marginalized. The sisters come from Kenya, Tanzania, and Uganda and their Mother House is in the Diocese of Lugazi, Uganda. The Little Sisters, in collaboration with associates, staff, benefactors, donors and volunteers are actively involved in works of mercy.

Seton House is located at 4801 Huntsman Trail, Quinton, VA 23141. The sister's convent is located at 11300 Continental Road, Quinton, VA 23141.

The sisters appreciate canned foods, soups, gelatin desserts, puddings, paper goods, laundry detergent, bleach, disinfectant wipes, non-latex gloves and wash cloths for bathing the residents.
