THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

By decision of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops and confirmation by the Holy See, whenever the Solemnities of Mary, Mother of God (Jan. 1), the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Aug. 15), or All Saints (Nov. 1) fall on a Saturday or a Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted. This year, the Assumption falls on a Monday is not a Holy Day of Obligation. However, SEAS Parish will be having Mass on Monday, Aug. 15 at 12:00 PM.

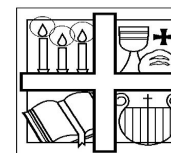
PRAYER FOR SPIRITUAL COMMUNION
