## St. Elizabeth Ann Seton

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton's Feast Day is Wednesday, January 4, 2023. In honor of this special day, we will be celebrating Mass at 11:00 AM.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first American saint, was born in New York City as Elizabeth Ann Bayley in 1774. She was brought up Episcopalian, but later became a convert to Catholicism. She was married at the age of 19 to William M. Seton and had five children. After she became a widow at the age of 29, she became a Catholic and foundress of the American parochial school system. She eventually founded the American chapter of the Daughters of Charity, which has over 4000 members today. She is the Patron Saint of our parish. She died in 1821 at the age of  $4\overline{7}$ .
