

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY (4/16)

Throughout the centuries Our Lord and His Blessed Mother have appeared to people of faith bringing a message of salvation and love. The message and devotion to Jesus as *The Divine Mercy* is based on the writings of St. Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun, who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary recording the revelations she received about God's mercy.

The message of mercy is that God loves us—all of us—no matter how great our sins. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Devotion to *The Divine Mercy* is a decision to trust completely in Him, to accept His mercy with thanksgiving, and to be merciful as He is merciful. By doing this you will gain great peace of mind and soul.



HVAC REPAIRS UPDATE

The parish has been getting quotes to replace the larger unit for the sanctuary, but due to the size of the heat pump and air handler (which will need to be replaced as well in the attic space), the total cost will run between \$12,000-\$16,500. We hope to have the replacement completed this week, but in the interim, we are grateful for everyone's patience and continued financial stewardship as we tackle this project.
