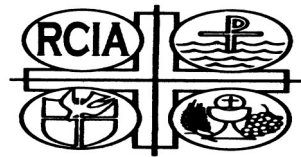

IRA QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

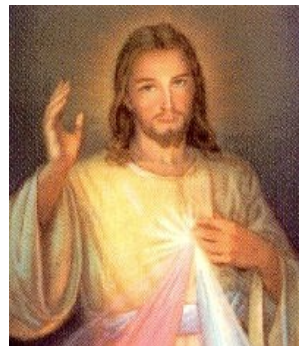

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY (4/16)

Throughout the centuries Our Lord and His Blessed Mother have appeared to people of faith bringing a message of salvation and love. The message and devotion to Jesus as *The Divine Mercy* is based on the writings of St. Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun, who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary recording the revelations she received about God's mercy.

The message of mercy is that God loves us—all of us—no matter how great our sins. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Devotion to *The Divine Mercy* is a decision to trust completely in Him, to accept His mercy with thanksgiving, and to be merciful as He is merciful. By doing this you will gain great peace of mind and soul.

Pamphlets on how to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and the Novena before Divine Mercy Sunday (the Second Sunday of Easter) are located by both Church entrances.

We are most grateful to all those who have worked to maintain their *Virtus* accounts and keep up with their monthly training bulletins. In order to prepare for the USCCB audit this summer, the Diocesan Office of Safe Environment is asking all parishes to ensure that safe environment requirements are being met by employees and volunteers. For volunteer requirements:

- Volunteer ScreeningONE background screening is valid and current, not expired.
- Completed *Virtus Protecting God's Children for Adults* Training.
- Up to date with monthly *Virtus* bulletins for Adults.
- Read and acknowledged the required documents: Safe Environment Regulations, Code of Ethical Conduct and Digital Communications and Media Policy.

We ask that all are in compliance no later than **Friday, April 28, 2023** in order to prevent *Virtus* account inactivation. If your account was inactivated in the last round due to inactivity and you wish to reinstate it, please contact the parish office.
