GUIDELINES FOR LENT 2024

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or the ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Fasting, almsgiving and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

The forty days from Ash Wednesday to Holy Thursday give us an opportunity to prepare for the greatest event in Salvation History, The Resurrection. Lent is a time for us to honestly look closely at our lives, to repent and to do something to improve our relationship with God. Take at least a few minutes each day to ask God to be with you throughout the day and guide your thoughts, words and actions. Thank God for all that is good in your life and ask Him to help you deal with the bad things that happen. More time given to prayer should bring us closer to the Lord.


