Early in-person voting began Sept. 20th and runs through Saturday, Nov. 2nd at 5:00 PM. The deadline to apply online, by fax, or by email for an absentee ballot is Friday, Oct. 25th at 5:00 PM. The Virginia Catholic Conference has put together voter education resources. Only materials provided by the Diocese, the Virginia Catholic Conference or the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) are authorized for distribution in parishes. 


THANKSGIVING BASKETS COORDINATOR & VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
